Dear Parent/Guardian

We are now in the final phase of the preparation of the GCSE and BTEC examination for your son/daughter. To make sure that this is as effective as possible we will move to the examination timetable from Thursday 20 May, following our "Suit Day" celebrations.

The exam timetable will continue to offer revision sessions within school, arranged and agreed by subject staff as they feel necessary. Should students be required for any sessions they must sign in at reception (A Block) and wear full school uniform.
