Acceptable Dress

Girls

- Dresses, skirts (of a mid-thigh length or longer) or trousers
- Smart shirt/blouse/T-shirt, short or long sleeved
- Cardigan or V-neck jumper
- Sensible shoes

Boys

- Trousers
- Smart shirt with collar, short or long sleeved or smart T-shirt with collar
- Cardigan or V-neck jumper
- Sensible shoes

Note: Tailored blazer, jacket or suit (with or without tie) are optional for boys and girls

Unacceptable Dress

- **No** denim can be worn
- **No** trainers
- **No** sportswear, beachwear or shorts
- Shoulders and stomach always covered
- **No** large emblems/prints on shirts/T shirts
- **No** offensive clothing
- **No** extremes of fashion
- **No** T-shirts without a collar
- **No** Leggings
