Dear Parents,

As part of the AQA AS course your son/daughter is required to carry out a field work investigation. This investigation will form part of their examination in January 2010.

A visit to Preston Montford field study centre, Shrewsbury has been arranged for Monday 19th - Tuesday 20th October 2009. The visit will involve taking river measurement at Ashes Hollow.

The cost of the visit is £90 and this includes tuition by the field study staff, use of equipment, dinner, bed, breakfast and lunch, and use of the classrooms to enable them to complete the study.

The minibus will leave school at 9am and return at approximately 4pm on Tuesday. Students should bring a very small bag (space is limited on the minibus) which includes packed lunch for Monday, writing equipment, waterproof clothing and wellies (these can be hired from the centre for a small charge).

Pupils may have the opportunity to visit the bowling/laser questing centre on the Monday evening. If your son/daughter wishes to take part in either of these activities they will need to bring a small amount of money with them.

Please return the blue form along with a cheque made payable to Aldridge School in an envelope with your child's name and 'Geography AS' on the front by 2nd October.
